- ✔ Clean architecture - well-organized components/sections structure

☒ Critical Improvements (Do First)

1. Add Performance Monitoring

Issue: No performance monitoring for 3D rendering

Solution: Add @react-three/drei PerformanceMonitor

2. Add Accessibility (a11y) to 3D Canvas

Issue: 3D canvas lacks keyboard navigation and screen reader support

Solution: Add aria-labels and keyboard controls

3. Optimize 3D Model Loading

Issue: CyberBot model may cause slow initial load

Solution: Add Draco compression and lazy loading

Impact: Reduces model size by 70-90%, faster load times [web:22]

4. Add Meta Tags for SEO

Issue: Missing comprehensive SEO metadata

Solution: Update app/layout.tsx

Current: HeroSection has good structure but could improve CTAs

Recommended changes:
